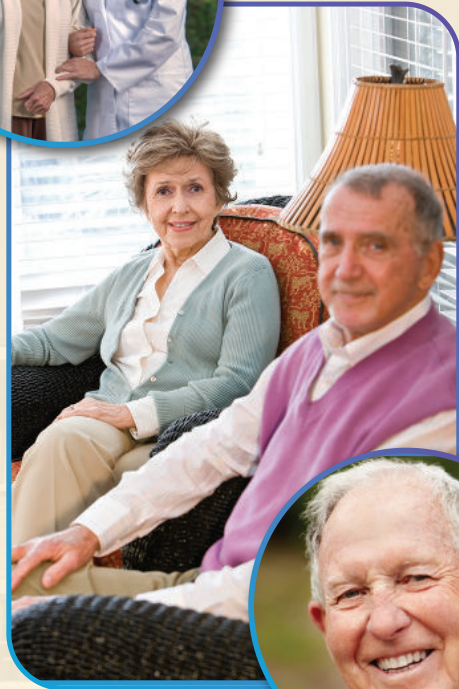
Payment/Insurance Coverage

- Fees are completely covered for individuals eligible for Medicaid or for both Medicare and Medicaid benefits. (Some Medicaid recipients may have a spend down.)
- Those ineligible for Medicaid and Medicare or eligible for Medicare only are responsible for a monthly fee, payable through private pay or private insurance (with prior approval).
- PACE CNY is a managed long-term care program.
- PACE CNY participants may be personally liable for costs of unauthorized or out-of-PACE program agreement services, other than emergency services.

Eligibility

- 55 years of age or older
- Qualify for nursing home level of care
- Qualify for long-term care services for more than 120 days
- Able to be maintained in the community safely at the time of enrollment
- Live in Onondaga County
